



## ABSTRACT SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS & FORM

Please note: Only those submissions which fully comply with these instructions will be reviewed. All complete applications received by **11:59 PM (CDT) on July 15, 2017** will be independently reviewed by the NNHRT Conference Abstract Selection Committee or a specifically assigned Track Subcommittee. Selection of abstracts for presentation at the Conference will be based on scientific merit. All abstract submissions will be made online, on the NNHRTI website: [NNHRTI.org/abstracts.html](http://NNHRTI.org/abstracts.html).

### Abstract Preparation

- Selection Criteria: All abstracts should address the appropriate selection criteria (Please refer to “Selection Criteria” contained in the Call for Abstracts.)
- Content: The text body of the abstract is **limited to 300** words, **excluding** Title and Author information (see below). You may type or paste the text into the Abstract Box. As appropriate for an abstract, including research, project/best practices, or theory development/concept analysis projects, the NNHRT Conference Abstract Selection Committee asks that you include content related to the specific implications and significance of the study for the discipline each discipline and how the results can be implemented in practice. In addition, please include or reference at least two learning objectives that meet the objectives of the conference (see Call for Abstracts).
- Titles: Abstract titles should be centered and in upper case letters.
- Authors: List all authors with the title. Place an asterisk (\*) in front of the presenting author’s name. At the bottom of the abstract, list the contacting author’s name and email address. ALL individuals involved in the study must be listed.
- Abstract Format: Submit full and complete abstract on this form.


